

SC Conceal Firearm Permit - NRA Basic Pistol Certification (2 for price of 1)

REQUIRED ITEMS

150 rounds of factory ammo (3 boxes)



Auto-Pistol with at least 2 magazines or Revolver and speed loader, if you have one

(Firearm may be rented (\$3.00) from instructor if you do not have one)



(Call instructor in advance to discuss – you will have to purchase ammo for the firearm you rent)

1. Eye/Ear protection (Glasses count as eye protection) – extra eye/ear protection will be on-hand
- 2: You should wear a belt that fits comfortably and provides good support for your hip holster
- 3: If females plan to carry their weapon in their purse, please bring an empty purse
(There will be classroom discussion reference conceal carry methods)
4. You may want to bring a baseball cap, and bottled water for the range

The **\$85.00 Instructional** fee per person must be paid (money order, cashier's check, personal check, or cash.) – Make check or money order payable to Robert Sirmons or Professional-One1. You can register and pay at www.Pro1IPA.com – click on the CWP link on the left side of "Home" page or register by contacting the instructor. **Cut off for registration is by 1200 p.m. Friday.** I must have at least three (3) students for class to be held. Additionally, for safety reasons, **ammunition is not allowed in the classroom.** All firearms must be inside a bag, back-pack, etc. when walking from your vehicle to the classroom. **Class maximum is eight (8).** Per SLED guidance, class room/range training will be at least 8 hours (may possibly go over 8 - Leave schedule open). First come/ serve - \$20.00 non-refundable deposit holds seat. (\$20.00 counts towards instructional fee above).

APPLICATION CHECK-LIST – ITEMS YOU NEED PRIOR TO MAILING TO SLED

You must bring a front and back "copy" of your South Carolina DL OR SC ID CARD to class.

THE BELOW ITEMS MUST BE MAILED TO SLED ONCE ALL CERTIFICATION TRAINING HAS BEEN COMPLETED.

Applicant must complete a SLED Form R-078 (SC Concealed Weapons Permit Application); obtain two (2) color photographs (no larger than 1"x1"); two (2) completed fingerprint cards; and complete your SLED CWP Certification, which is provided by the instructor. You can visit: <http://www.sled.sc.gov/documents/CWPApplicationForm.pdf> and complete the application (Form R-078) or complete one in class. The application, SLED CWP Certification Certificate, 2 photographs, 2 fingerprint cards, and a cashier's check, certified check, or money order in the amount of **\$50.00**, made payable to South Carolina Law Enforcement Division (SLED), must be **MAILED TO: SLED Regulatory, P.O. Box 21398, Columbia, SC 29221-1398.** Allow approximately (90) days for processing (it may be processed sooner than 90 days).

Transportation of firearms:

SECTION 16-23-20. Unlawful carrying of handgun exceptions: It is unlawful for anyone to carry about the person any handgun, whether concealed or not, except as follows, unless otherwise specifically prohibited by law: (9) a person in a vehicle if the handgun is secured in a closed glove compartment, closed console, closed trunk, or in a closed container secured by an integral fastener and transported in the luggage compartment of the vehicle; however, this item is not violated if the glove compartment, console, or trunk is opened in the presence of a law enforcement officer for the sole purpose of retrieving a driver's license, registration, or proof of insurance. Under the seat, on the seat or in the door pouch is NOT Permissible. It must be in the glove box, console or trunk. If you are stopped by Law enforcement, declare the weapon at your earliest opportunity!! Do NOT reach for or move in any way that may be perceived as a threat to the officer!!!!
